ORDER NO. 3 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Carroll Water Company, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC regarding the application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Ellis County.

On January 19, 2022, the applicants filed the affidavit of Aaron Silas, regulatory case manager for CSWR-Texas, attesting that notice was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on January 14, 2022. Attached to the affidavit were copies of the notice and map provided by the applicants.

On February 8, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the sufficiency of the notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for applicants to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation	April 4, 2022
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	May 16, 2022 ¹

¹ 120 days from the date of completed notice (January 14, 2022) is Saturday, May 14, 2022. Therefore, the deadline advances to the next business day, Monday, May 16, 2022, under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(a).
