**ORDER NO. 9
FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT
AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the November 29, 2021 application of Carroll Water Company, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR Texas) for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Ellis County.

On June 30, 2022, the applicants filed closing documentation. The closing documentation included a fully executed general assignment and bill of sale, showing consummation of the sale on May 31, 2022; and an affidavit attesting all customer deposits held by Walter J. Carroll Water Company were returned or refunded to customers. Additionally, there are no customers with deposits being transferred.

On July 15, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the closing documentation.

The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule:
