Pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.257(r) and (s), CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR Texas), holder of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 13290 and sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 21120, hereby files this Boundary Description for the CSWR Texas water system, which is located in Polk and Montgomery Counties, Texas.

In accordance with the aforementioned statute, CSWR Texas affirmatively states that its water and sewer service area included in the aforementioned CCNs is as follows:

The requested water service area includes:

- a. Deerwood (includes Deerwood Subdivision Sections 3,4,5 and 6) in Montgomery County: The requested area includes 101 customer connections, is located approximately nine miles east of downtown Conroe, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Cabo San Lucas; on the east and south by White Rock Road; and on the west by Crockett Martin Road. The requested water area includes approximately 128 acres.
