ORDER NO. 5
FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY
COMPLETE, WAIVING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the November 29, 2021 application of Flat Fork Water Supply Corporation and the City of Center for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities in Shelby County. On February 17, 2022, applicants filed a supplement to the application.

On February 23, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, notice, and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete. In addition, because the applicants indicate that only 39 meters will be transferred to the City of Center, which already supplies water to the 39 meters through a previous agreement with Flat Fork Water, notice under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(c) is waived.
