**ORDER NO. 8**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the November 29, 2021, application filed by Flat Fork Water Supply Corporation and the City of Center for sale, transfer, or merger (STM) of facilities in Shelby County. The applicants filed a supplement on February 17, 2022. On June 3, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental amended recommendation regarding the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Commission Staff's supplemental amended recommendation using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
