COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On December 2, 2021, Lili and Thomas McDevitt (Complainants) filed a complaint against Levi Water Supply Corporation (Levi WSC) regarding denial of water service. The Complainants filed the formal complaint pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.242.

On December 3, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, requiring a response from Levi WSC by December 23, 2021, and requiring Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a statement of position regarding the complaint by December 31, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. As of the time of this filing, Levi WSC has yet to file a response to this complaint. The Commission is closed on December 24, 27, 28, and 31, 2021. Accordingly, Staff requests that the deadline for Staff's statement of position be extended to January 14, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests an order consistent with the foregoing request.
