## ORDER NO. 2 GRANTING EXTENSIONS

This Order addresses the extension requests filed by Commission Staff and Levi Water Supply Corporation on December 22, 2021.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff and Levi WSC's requests.

By January 7, 2022, Levi WSC must file a response to the complaint, as required by 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.78. The response must address the following: (1) the Commission's jurisdiction over this proceeding; (2) allegations raised in the complaint; (3) applicable statutes, rules, orders, and tariff provisions; (4) copies of any rates or tariffs that are the subject of this complaint; and (5) any other matters relevant to the complaint.

By January 21, 2022, Commission Staff must file a statement of position regarding the complaint. As part of the statement of position, Commission Staff must address whether Lili and Thomas McDevitt complied with the requirement for informal resolution in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.242(c), and the requirement to first present the complaint to the city in which the subject property is located, if applicable, in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.242(e)(1).
