FINDING INFORMAL RESOLUTION REQUIREMENTS WERE MET AND
REQUIRING SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT OF POSITION

On December 2, 2021, Lili and Thomas McDevitt filed a complaint against Levi Water Supply Corporation regarding Levi WSC's alleged refusal to provide service.


On January 22, 2022, Commission Staff filed its statement of position. In its statement of position, Commission Staff states that the facts of this case are in dispute and requests 45 days to conduct informal discussions with the complainants and Levi WSC and to issue formal discovery if necessary.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds that the complainants have complied with the Commission's requirements for informal resolution, in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.242, and that the requirements of 16 TAC § 22.242(e) do not apply to this proceeding.

By March 7, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental statement of position regarding the complaint.
