# COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE

On December 3, 2021, Glenda Sue Winker (Petitioner) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Marilee Special Utility District's (Marilee SUD) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10150 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Petitioner asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Collin County, which is a qualifying county. <sup>1</sup> According to the U.S. Census Bureau, Collin County has a population of 782,341.<sup>2</sup> Additionally, Collin County is adjacent to Dallas County, which has a population of 2,368,139.<sup>3</sup> Petitioner filed supplemental information on January 11, 2022.

On January 6, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, establishing a deadline of February 15, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file comments on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the petition and supplemental information and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Pai Liu, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition is administratively incomplete. Staff further recommends that Petitioner be ordered to cure the deficiencies identified in Ms. Liu's memorandum by March 11, 2022, and that Staff be given a

deadline of March 25, 2022 to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative

completeness of the petition.

schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural

schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the petition be found administratively

complete.

Ш. **CONCLUSION** 

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the petition be found

administratively incomplete, and that Petitioner be ordered to file supplemental information to cure

the deficiencies in the petition by March 11, 2022. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order

consistent with these recommendations.
