**LIFTING ABATEMENT, CONSOLIDATING DOCKETS, RESTYLING
THE CASE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses consolidation, restyling, abatement, and a procedural schedule for continued processing.

On March 1, 2023, the parties to the above-styled and numbered proceedings filed an agreed motion to consolidate the dockets, indicating that Lamesa Solar II, LLC and Midway Solar, LLC have common corporate parents and overlapping management. Additionally, both proceedings involve common facts, which led to Commission Staff's filing Notices of Violation of the same alleged violations and fact patterns. For these reasons, the parties agree to consolidation for resolution in a single settlement agreement and proceeding.

I. Consolidation

In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.34(a), the administrative law judge (ALJ) consolidates Docket Nos. 52927 and 52928 into Docket No. 52927. All future filings must be made only in Docket No. 52927, which is restyled as follows: *Notice of Violations of Lamesa Solar, LLC and Midway Solar, LLC for Violations of 16 TAC § 25.55, Concerning Winter Weather Readiness Reporting Requirements.*

So that the record is complete, the ALJ deems all documents filed prior to the date of this Order on the Commission's Interchange in Docket No. 52928 to be incorporated by reference and also part of the record for Docket No. 52927. Docket No. 52928 is hereby closed.

II. Lifting Abatement

So that the consolidated proceeding may continue to final resolution, the ALJ lifts the abatement.

III. Establishing Deadline for Procedural Schedule

By March 16, 2023, the parties must file a proposed procedural schedule for continued processing.
