
**RULE 11 AGREEMENT**

Pursuant to Rule 11 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and OCI Alamo 1 LLC (OCI) (collectively, Parties) agree to be bound by the following during the pendency of this case to the same extent as if these terms were ordered by the Administrative Law Judge.

**The Parties agree as follows:**


1. The deadline for OCI to file its Motion to Compel Responses to OCI's First Set of RFIs to Commission Staff shall be extended for seven working days from Thursday, May 26, 2022, to Tuesday, June 7, 2022.
2. The deadline for Staff to file its Response to OCI's Objections to Staff's Direct Testimony shall be extended for seven working days from Friday, June 3, 2022, to Tuesday, June 14, 2022.
3. The Parties will use the time provided to negotiate in good faith to address a possible settlement of the issues in this case.
4. This Rule 11 Agreement will be filed and made a part of the record in this case.
