# ADMITTING EVIDENCE; REMANDING CASE TO THE COMMISSION; AND DISMISSING CASE FROM SOAH'S DOCKET

On September 2, 2022, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and OCI Alamo 1, LLC (OCI, and, together, the Parties) filed a joint motion (Motion) to admit evidence and remand this case to the Commission. On the same day, the Parties filed a Notice of Settlement Agreement (Agreement) that resolves all issues in this proceeding.

The Motion requests that the following documents be admitted into evidence:

- 1. Commission Staff's petition to determine violation and impose an administrative penalty (Interchange Item No. 3);
- 2. OCI's request for hearing (Interchange Item No. 4);
- 3. The settlement agreement and all attachments filed on September 2, 2022; and
- 4. The proposed order attached to the Motion as Attachment 1.

The Motion also requests that this proceeding be remanded to the Commission to consider the Agreement and proposed order.

As demonstrated by the Agreement, there are no remaining contested issues, and no hearing is required in this proceeding. Accordingly, the Motion is **GRANTED**. The above-referenced documents are **ADMITTED**, and this case is **REMANDED** to the Commission and **DISMISSED** from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
