COMMISSION STAFF'S CORRECTIONS TO THE PROPOSED ORDER

The Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) offers corrections to two conclusions of law proposed by the administrative law judge (ALJ) in the November 2, 2022 proposed order. The deadline to file corrections or exceptions to the proposed order is November 16, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. Conclusions of Law

Commission Staff recommends minor, typographical corrections to proposed Conclusions of Law No. 3 and 4. As noted by the ALJ in the proposed order at Footnote No. 1, the petition to determine a violation at issue in this case was filed on December 8, 2021. Subsequently, the Commission amended 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.55, effective October 20, 2022. The ALJ specified that all references and citations to 16 TAC § 25.55 in the proposed order are made in reference to the version of the rule in effect at the time the petition was filed. However, proposed Conclusions of Law No. 2 and 3 appear to reference subsections of the current version of the rule, rather than the version applicable at the time of the petition. Accordingly, Commission Staff recommends that Conclusions of Law No. 3 and 4 be amended as follows:

- 3. On December 1, 2021, Shell was a generation entity as defined under 16 TAC § 25.55(b)(23).
- 4. On December 1, 2021, each of the four Deer Park Refinery generation facilities was a generation resource as defined under 16 TAC § 25.55(b)(34).
