RULE 11 AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Rule 11 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and Texas Big Spring, LLC¹ (TBS) (collectively, Parties) agree to be bound by the following during the pendency of this case to the same extent as if these terms were ordered by the administrative law judge.

The Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The deadline for Commission Staff to file its Direct Testimony or Statement of Position shall be extended from June 10, 2022, to June 24, 2022.
- 2. The deadline for TBS to file its Objection to Staff Direct Testimony shall be extended from June 24, 2022, to July 8, 2022.
- 3. The deadline for Commission Staff to file its Response to TBS's Objections to Staff's Direct Testimony shall be extended from July 8, 2022, to July 22, 2022.
- 4. The deadline for TBS serve discovery on Staff's direct testimony shall be extended from July 15, 2022, to July 29, 2022.
- 5. The parties will use the time provided to negotiate in good faith to address a possible settlement of the issues in this case.

- 6. The subsequent deadlines set forth in SOAH Order No. 2 dated April 6, 2022, shall be revised as needed if a settlement cannot be reached during the time provided above.
- 7. This Rule 11 Agreement will be filed and made a part of the record in this case.
