ORDER NO. 3
FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT, PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE,
AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Quadvest, LP. On March 4, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.235, the applicant must prepare the notice prescribed in the Commission's application form, including all information listed in the Commission's instructions for completing a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) application. Quadvest retyped and reformatted the Commission's form and omitted in the notice it mailed to every entity that the requested area is also comprised of 4 acres of decertified area (from CCN numbers 11612 and 20952). Additionally, under 16 TAC § 24.235(b)(1)(A), an applicant for a CCN amendment must mail notice to cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area. Quadvest failed to notice the Harris County Municipal Utility District (MUD) 441 as recommended in the January 18, 2022 memorandum of Patricia Garcia and ordered in Order No. 2.

The administrative law judge finds the notice insufficient. The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a supplemental procedural schedule	April 12, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
