FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of the application of Quadvest, LP. To amend its certificates of convenience and necessity. On July 14, 2022, Commission Staff filed a second supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.


On February 17, 2022, Quadvest filed a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in *The Cyprus Creek Mirror*, a newspaper of general circulation in Harris and Montgomery counties, on February 2 and 9, 2022. On June 6, 2022, Quadvest filed the affidavit of Mark L. Urback, Quadvest's executive manager of engineering and construction, attesting that notice of the application was mailed to current customers and affected parties on May 20 and June 3, 2022.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Event	Date
Deadline for intervention	July 5, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicant for review and consent	August 15, 2022
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	August 29, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 6, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	September 27, 2022
