COMMISSION STAFF’S FIRST REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On December 15, 2021, Quadvest, LP (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Harris and Montgomery Counties. Quadvest holds water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952. Quadvest seeks to add approximately 185 acres of uncertificated area.

On July 15, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 8 requiring Quadvest and the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) (collectively, Parties) to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law by September 27, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs additional time to prepare the joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. As such, Staff respectfully requests an extension of its deadline until October 5, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff’s deadline to October 5, 2022 to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law.
