JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE

COMES NOW, the City of Austin ("City" or "Austin"), Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation ("Creedmoor"), and the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Staff") (collectively, the "Parties") and submit this Joint Motion to Admit Evidence. In support thereof, the Parties respectfully show the following.

I. Background

On December 16, 2021, Creedmoor and Austin executed a Water Service Area Transfer Agreement (the "Service-Area Contract") to transfer approximately 31.65 acres of service from Creedmoor under CCN number 11029 to Austin under CCN number 11322. On December 21, 2021, Creedmoor and Austin filed the application at issue in this proceeding ("the Application") for approval of the Service-Area Contract and to amend CCN numbers 11029 and 11322. In Order No. 2 filed on January 24, 2022 the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") found the Application to be administratively complete and that public notice was sufficient.

On March 1, 2022, Austin, and on March 15, 2022, Creedmoor filed their consents to the map and certificates provided by Commission Staff on February 25, 2022. On March 11, 2022, Commission Staff filed is final recommendation supporting approval of the Application.

II. Joint Motion to Admit Evidence

The Parties move to admit the following into the record of evidence in this proceeding.

- a. The Application dated December 21, 2021 (Interchange Item No. 1);
- b. Commission Staff's recommendation on sufficiency of the Application and notice, dated January 20, 2022 (Interchange Item No. 3);
- c. Austin's consent to the final map and certificate, filed on March 1, 2022 (Interchange Item No. 6);
- d. Creedmoor's consent to the final map and certificate, filed on March 15, 2022 (Interchange Item No. 8);
- e. Commission Staff's Final Recommendation, filed on March 11, 2022, recommending that the Application be approved (Interchange Item No. 7); and
- f. The final maps and certificates, which are attached to this Joint Motion to Admit Evidence.

III. Joint Proposed Notice of Approval

The Parties have agreed on the attached Joint Proposed Notice of Approval, which would grant the Application.

IV. Conclusion

The Parties respectfully request that the items listed above be admitted into the record of this proceeding as evidence and that the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs from the attached Joint Proposed Notice of Approval be adopted.
