COMES NOW, Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation (“Creedmoor”), and the City of Austin, Texas (“Austin”) (collectively, “the Applicants”) and file this Joint Proof of Recording pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 8 in the Notice of Approval issued by the Honorable Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) on April 25, 2022. I. Proof of Recording

1. On April 25, 2022, the Honorable ALJ issued the Notice of Approval in this docket. Specifically, Ordering Paragraph 8 requires that the Applicants file proof of compliance with the following: (i) compliance with the recording requirements in Texas Water Code § 13.257(r) and (s) for the areas in Travis County affected by the petition; and (ii) file proof of compliance with the recording requirements by no later than 45 days after the date the Notice of Approval is signed. Therefore, this Joint Proof of Recording is timely filed.

2. Pursuant to the Notice of Approval, the Applicants jointly recorded the following documents (attached as “**Exhibit A**”) on May 26, 2022 in the Travis County real property records:

- a) a certified copy of the revised CCN certificates issued to both Creedmoor and Austin in the Notice of Approval;
 - b) a certified copy of the revised CCN map issued in the Notice of Approval; and
 - c) a boundary description of the service area.
3. Therefore, the Applicants jointly satisfied the requirements of Texas Water Code § 13.257(r) and (s), and Ordering Paragraph 8.

II. Conclusion

Applicants jointly file this Proof of Recording and respectfully request that the Honorable ALJ find it sufficient and in compliance with the Notice of Approval and Texas Water Code recording requirements.

**AFFIDAVIT OF RECORDING
PURSUANT TO SECTION 13.257 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE**

Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation (“Creedmoor”), holder of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11029, does hereby submit the following documents for recording in the real property records of Travis County, Texas. Creedmoor submits this recording on its own behalf and on behalf of the City of Austin, Texas (“City”), holder of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11322, which is also a party to the Public Utility Commission of Texas proceeding that forms the basis for the amendments to the water service area boundaries of Creedmoor and the City, which are documented in this recording.

This recording is required by Texas Water Code §§ 13.257(r) and (s), which provide:

(r) A utility service provider shall:

(1) record in real property records of each county in which the service area or a portion of the service area is located a certified copy of the map of the certificate of public convenience and necessity and of any amendment to the certificate as contained in the utility commission’s records, and a boundary description as contained in the utility commission’s records, and a boundary description of the service area by:

(A) a metes and bounds survey certified by a licensed state land surveyor or a registered professional land surveyor;

(B) the Texas State Plane Coordinate System;

(C) verifiable landmarks, including a road, creek, or railroad line;
or

(D) if a recorded plat of the area exists, lot and block number; and

(2) submit to the utility commission evidence of the recording.

(s) Each county shall accept and file in its real property records a utility service provider’s map presented to the county clerk under this section if the map meets filing requirements, does not exceed 11 inches by 17 inches in size, and is accompanied by the appropriate fee. The recording required by this section must be completed not later than the 31st day after the date a utility service provider receives a final order from the utility commission granting an application for a new certificate or for an amendment to a certificate that results in a change in the utility service provider’s service area.






