**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, NOTICE,**  
**SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the December 21, 2021 application of the City of Austin and Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend certificates of convenience and necessity in Travis County. On January 20, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete. Further, the ALJ finds that the petitioners have satisfied the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.253(c) and that no further notice is required.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	March 25, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	April 8, 2022
