ORDER NO. 5
GRANTING EXTENSION, LIFTING ABATEMENT, AND
ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the December 22, 2021 petition by Michael D. Dry to amend Monarch Utilities I, LP's water certificate of convenience and necessity in Tarrant County by streamlined expedited release.

In Order No. 3 filed on April 4, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the application administratively incomplete and provided a deadline for the petitioner to file information to cure the deficiencies. On April 8, 2022, the petitioner filed an appeal of Order No. 3. In Order No. 4 filed on April 11, 2022, the ALJ abated this proceeding until April 26, 2022. On April 18, 2022, Commission Advising filed notice that the Commission voted to not add the appeal ballot to any open meeting agenda.

On April 25, 2022, the petitioner filed a motion for extension of time. The petitioner represents that Commission Staff does not oppose the request.


The ALJ grants the petitioner's request for an extension, lifts the abatement of this proceeding, and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing.

Event	Date
Deadline for petitioner to file information to cure deficiencies identified in Patricia Garcia's January 24, 2022 memorandum, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation	May 9, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the petition and sufficiency of notice and propose procedural schedule	June 9, 2022

A deadline for Monarch to file a response to the petition will be established in a subsequent order.¹ Additional deadlines will be established if the petition is deemed administratively complete.
