Petitioner Michael D. Dry ("Dry") submits this Motion for Extension of Time to continue to resolve the issues outlined in Order numbers 3 and 4. Specifically, Dry requests a two-week extension of time to continue to work with the PUC to resolve the mapping issues cited in the March 25, 2022 memorandum of Patricia Garcia and to resolve the common ownership issue cited in the ALJ's Order No. 3. Thus, Dry proposes that the abatement of this proceeding set forth by the Administrative Law Judge in Order No. 5 be extended to May 23, 2022.
