## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the December 22, 2021 petition by Michael D. Dry to amend Monarch Utilities I, LP's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Tarrant County by streamlined expedited release. On January 24, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the January 24, 2022 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

A deadline for Monarch to file a response to the petition will be established in a subsequent order.<sup>1</sup> Additional deadlines will be established if the petition is deemed administratively complete.
