### ORDER NO. 5 FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT FOR FURTHER REVIEW AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSE TO MOTION TO DISMISS

This Order addresses the sufficiency of Simply Aquatics, Inc.'s January 10, 2022 application for a class D rate adjustment. In Order No. 4 filed on March 28, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the petition incomplete and ordered Simply Aquatics to cure the deficiency by April 11, 2022. Simply Aquatics failed to do so. The ALJ finds the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient.

On April 25, 2022, Commission Staff filed a motion to dismiss. Commission Staff recommends dismissal, without prejudice, for failure to amend the application such that it is sufficient after repeated determinations that the application is insufficient.

If Simply Aquatics wishes to respond to Commission Staff's motion to dismiss, it must do so by May 16, 2022.
