ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT FOR FURTHER REVIEW, AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of Simply Aquatics, Inc.'s January 10, 2022 application for a class D rate adjustment. On March 25, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation that the application be found insufficient for further review as more fully described in Maxine Gilford's February 23, 2022 memorandum attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The administrative law judge finds the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. By April 11, 2022, Simply Aquatics must file the information to cure the identified deficiencies. By April 25, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate. By the same date, Commission Staff may file a motion to dismiss, if it deems such a motion appropriate.
