On this the 10 day of July, 1950, the City Council of the City of Moulton, Texas, convened in Regular session at the regular meeting place thereof with the following members present, to-wit:

and the following absent: Julius J. Krajci, constituting a quorum present, at which time, the following, among other business, was transacted:

Alderman Joe Biehunko introduced a proposed ordinance. The ordinance was read in full.

The Mayor announced that the ordinance had been finally passed.

The ordinance is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SEWER SERVICE; PRESCRIBING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined that it is to the best interest of the City of Moulton and of its citizens to build and purchase a sanitary sewer system for said City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council is at this time in the process of issuing bonds for the purpose of financing the building and purchasing of a sanitary sewer system; and,

WHEREAS, it is proper and necessary in connection with said sanitary sewer system for the payment of operating expense and for the payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds to at this time set the rates to be charged for service in connection with said system;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOULTON, TEXAS:

I. RATES: That there shall be charged for sewer service in said City for each month the following rates:

A. RESIDENTIAL:

Minimum monthly charge of \$1.50, including five (5) fixtures; each additional fixture 30¢ per fixture.

B. COMMERCIAL:

Filling Stations, garages, or combinations.

Minimum monthly charge of \$1.50, including four ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) fixtures; each additional fixture 30¢ per fixture. Wash rack \$1.50 per month additional.

Laundries

Flat charge of \$5.00 per month. ✓

Hotels, rooming houses, and tourist courts.

Minimum monthly charge of \$1.50, including four ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) fixtures; each additional fixture 30¢ per fixture.

Cafes, beer parlors, or combination.

Minimum monthly charge of \$2.00; including four ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) fixtures; each additional fixture 30¢ per fixture.

Schools

Flat charge of \$5.00 per month.

All tapping connections to the city sewerage collecting system shall be made by the City.

II. TIME AND PLACE OF PAYMENTS: All accounts shall be payable on the 10 th. day of each month, at the City Hall in Moulton, Texas. The City Secretary shall prepare statements for the sewer service on the 1 st. day of each month. He shall discontinue service to any connection on which the statement shall not have been paid on or before the 10 th. day of the month following the date of the statement.

III. REPEALING CLAUSE: It is further ordained that all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, heretofore adopted and in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

IV. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: By reason of the fact that the City Council considers the passage of this ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public business of the City of Moulton, Texas, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure demanding

ORDINANCE

PRESCRIBING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR WATER SERVICE; PRESCRIBING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS ; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY .

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined that it is to the best interest of the City and of its citizens that certain repairs, extensions and improvements be made to the Waterworks System of the City of Moulton, Texas: and

WHEREAS, it is proper and necessary in connection with said Waterworks System for the payment of Maintenance and operating expenses and for the payment of the principal of and interest on bonds (If there be any) to, at this time, set the rates to be charged for service in connection with said Waterworks System :

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOULTON, TEXAS :

I. RATES : That there shall be charged for water service in said City for each month the following rates :

- (1) A minimum charge of \$ 2.00 per month, based on the use of 2000 gallons or less.
- (2) That all water in excess of the minimum charge hereinabove fixed shall be as follows:  
Next 3000 gallons 50¢ per 1000 gallons.  
Next 5000 gallons 40¢ per 1000 gallons .  
Next 10,000 gallons 30¢ per 1000 gallons.  
Next 10,000 gallons 20¢ per 1000 gallons.  
Next 1000 & up gallons 15¢ per 1000 gallons.

II. TIME AND PLACE OF PAYMENT : All accounts shall be payable on the 1st day of each month, at the City Hall in Moulton, Texas. The City Secretary shall prepare statements for the water services on the 20th day of each month. He shall discontinue service to any connection on which the statement shall not have been paid on or before the 20th day of the month following the date of the statement.

III. REPEALING CLAUSE : It is further ordained that all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, heretofore adopted and in conflict herewith, are hereby expressly repealed.

IV. EMERGENCY CLAUSE : By reason of the fact that the City Council considers the passage of this ordinance necessary for

the preservation of the public business of the City of Moulton, Texas, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure demanding that the rule requiring ordinances to be read at more than one meeting of the City Council be suspended, and that this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is so ordained.
