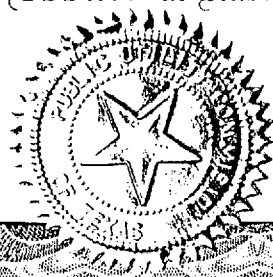
CITY OF OMAHA, TEXAS
