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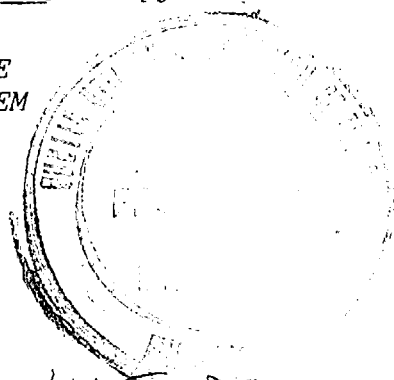

The Appendix contains a sample of each service agreement form used by the above utility and a condensation of Substantive Rules of the Commission.

SECTION A RATE SCHEDULE

For residential service only

Billing monthly, on or about the 1st.

Rate: \$ flat rate \$7.⁰⁰ per mo. unless other rate approved by Commission.

No penalty for late payment.

No deposit required from qualified applicants. Qualified applicant means a

lot purchaser for cash on an approved Contract.

Disconnection may be made only for delinquency and then after legal notice has been given of intention to re-possess as authorized in the Property report, and Contract. Developer retained a lien on each lot to secure payment of water and maintenance fees. Meters not in use at present but may be installed at request of and at the expense of user.

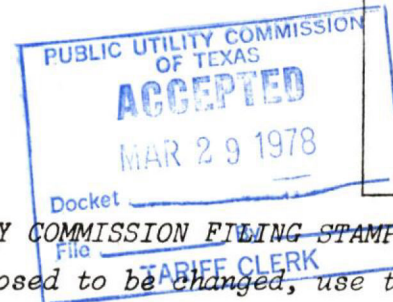

SECTION B SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. when lot purchased and application is made, owner entitled to tap existing water connection already provided in underground meter box.
2. no deposit required.
3. Developer retains Lien on all lots to secure Payment
4. no meter presently used but lot owner may have one upon request by agreeing to pay for access water usage and paying for the meter & debt, obligation to 3000
5. Developer limits his water obligation to 3000 Gal. for one per lot unless a meter is requested.
6. accurate meters to be used and a special Test may be had upon request for \$15.⁰⁰

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SECTION C EXTENSION POLICY

No contribution in aid of construction may be required of any customer except as provided for in the following extension policy, which must be a consistent, non-discriminatory policy which is subject to the approval of the Commission.

1. Not applicable.
2. all lots in development had water lines, connections and meter boxes installed at corner of lot at the time streets were installed. underground electric lines and points of connection for electric lines were placed at time development made also street lights were provided initially
3. water lines from meter box to residence is by user. Electric line extension from pedestal to home is by elec. utility upon request at a cost of \$1.00 per foot plus meter loop.

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
