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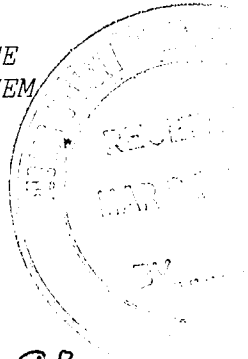

TAP FEE.....\$ 125.00

RECONNECTION FEE.....\$ 15.00

SECTION B SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Customer makes application for service at our office. All customers pay a \$3.50 service charge for turn-on.

A deposit is required of renters.

Customer pays regular rates for water metered. Bill is due upon receipt.

SECTION C EXTENSION POLICY

No contribution in aid of construction may be required of any customer except as provided for in the following extension policy, which must be a consistent, non-discriminatory policy which is subject to the approval of the Commission.

Any extension is done at the cost of the company. New customers are charged \$125.00 for a new connection. This is based on cost of materials to set meter.

Our systems blanket our operating area at present and no extensions are anticipated.
