



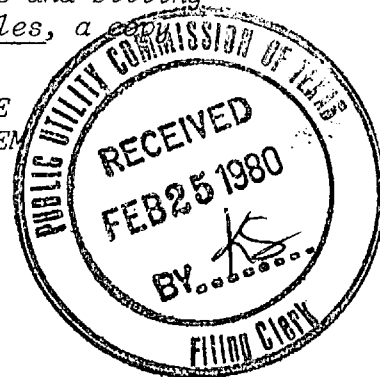

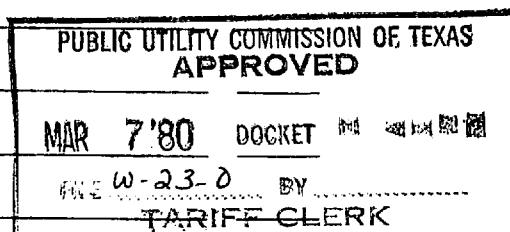



To Whom It May Concern:

Beginning August 1, 1977, connection fees are Two-Hundred-Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). This includes the tap at the main water line and meter connections. Customers must furnish 3/4 inch service pipe from meter to home connections.

Stonecrest Water Department is not responsible for installing or damage to water lines beyond the meter.

When a customer moves from a lot, the water will be shut off and a connection fee of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) will be charged to anyone moving onto a lot, where there is an existing tap and meter.
