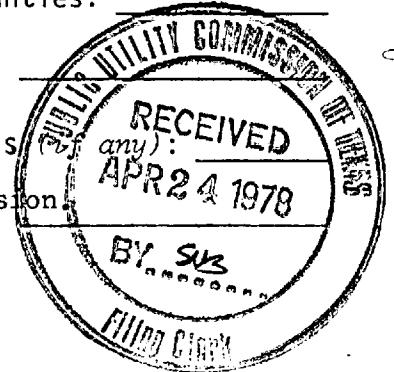

SECTION B SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS

~~NOT TO BE USED FOR THIS PURPOSE~~

1. Any person desiring to be connected to Indian Lake Estates water system must receive a permit from the office and pay installation meter charge of \$88.00.
2. All property owners are responsible for having a working meter and in an accessible place for reading meter.
3. The exception to the above no. 2 is:
  - a. If the property owner has signed a letter transferring the meter to Indian Lake Estates and the letter is on file in the office.
4. Meter will be read every three month period (March, June, Sept, Dec.). Minimum meter charge is billed at month end on the other eight months.
5. Water may be disconnected upon a written notice to the property owner for non payment of water. This notice will state the amount past due and the final date due before disconnection. If water is disconnected there will be a charge of \$50.00 to reconnect the water.
6. Property owner will be charged the monthly minimum charge on each additional unit using water from one meter.

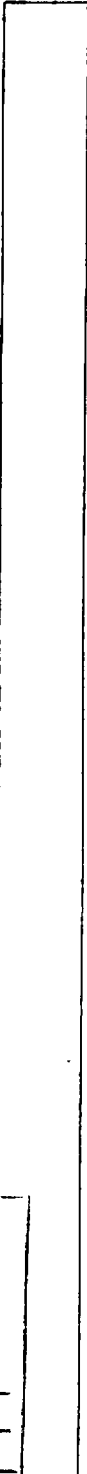
