Dear Member,

In the Mystic Oak Water Co-Op members meeting of October 21st the attending members agreed that the water systems monthly operational costs should be collected monthly rather than depending on high water usage revenue brought in mostly in the hot, dry months. The board chose the most equitable solution to accomplish this objective. The proposal to figure monthly water bills to the nearest one hundred gallons used was considered and found to entail excessive figuring and bookkeeping and would have required the monthly basic charge to increase by one dollar to offset the lower income by rounding down to the nearest one hundred gallons used. The new minimum gallons used will increase from 5,000 to 10,000. The new rate for 10,000 gallons to 20,000 gallons has decreased by .50¢ per thousand and from 20,000 gallons up has decreased by .25¢ per thousand.

The new rate will be implemented in December and is as follows:

10,000 gallons, basic minimum monthly	\$30.00
10,000 to 20,000 gallons	1.50 per thous.
20,000 up	2.00 per thous.

The Aquifer District fee of .25¢ per thousand gallons must still be collected for each 1,000 gallons used.




