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PETITION OF INSPIRATION WEST, LLC TO AMEND SEIS LAGOS UTILITY DISTRICT'S WATER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN COLLIN COUNTY BY STREAMLINED EXPEDITED RELEASE **PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION**

COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE

On January 12, 2022, Inspiration West, LLC (Inspiration West) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Seis Lagos Utility District's (Seis Lagos) sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11256 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Inspiration West asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Collin County, which is a qualifying county. Inspiration West filed supplemental information on February 4, 2022 and February 25, 2022.

On February 17, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2, establishing a deadline of April 14, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file supplemental comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the petition and supplemental information and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition is administratively complete. Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness is not a comment on the merits of the petition.

II. NOTICE SUFFICIENCY

Under 16 TAC § 24.245(h)(3)(f), a landowner seeking streamlined expedited release must provide proof that a copy of the petition has been mailed to the current CCN holder via certified mail on the day that the landowner submits the petition to the Commission. Inspiration West included a certificate of service stating that it mailed a copy of its petition to the CCN holder, Seis Lagos, by certified mail on the day the petition was filed with the Commission. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the notice is sufficient.

III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Under 16 TAC § 24.245(h)(7), there is an expedited deadline of 60 days for approval of the requested release that begins once the ALJ issues an order finding a petition administratively complete. Staff recommends that the petition be found administratively complete. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule and requests that the ALJ populate the deadlines accordingly when the ALJ issues that order.

 $^{^2}$ It is critical for Staff to know as soon as possible after the Commission grants the petition whether Staff needs to secure the services of a third appraiser. If the petitioner and CCN holder are unable to agree and fail to make this filing, Staff may need additional time to file its appraiser's report.

On January 12, 2022, Inspiration West, LLC (Inspiration West) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Seis Lagos Utility District's (Seis Lagos) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11256 in Collin County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Inspiration West asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Collin County, which is a qualifying county.

Inspiration West submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the property was not receiving water service from Seis Lagos and a warranty deed confirming Inspiration West's ownership of the tract of land. Based on the mapping review by Tracy Montes and Hank Journeay, Infrastructure Division, the digital data filed with Item 3 on February 4, 2022, and maps submitted with Item 6 on February 25, 2022, are sufficient for determining the location of the tract of land considered for streamlined expedited release is located within Seis Lagos's water CCN.

The landowner's total property is approximately 73.2 acres. The tract of land in the petition for streamlined expedited release is approximately 72.5 acres, of which approximately 72 acres overlap Seis Lagos Utility District (CCN No. 11256) and would be decertified from CCN No. 11256.

The petition also includes a statement indicating a copy of the petition was sent via certified mail to Seis Lagos on the date the petition was filed with the Commission.

Based on the mapping review by Tracy Montes and Hank Journeay, and my technical and managerial review of the additional information provided by Inspiration West on February 4, 2022 and February 25, 2022, I recommend the petition be deemed administratively complete and accepted for filing.
