ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the January 26 and 27, 2022 application of Liquid Utilities LLC to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On March 14 and May 6, 2022, Liquid supplemented its application.

On June 28, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the petitioners to provide notice of the application as described in the June 28, 2022 memorandum of Jolie Mathis attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms.
