## ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of the application of Liquid Utilities LLC to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On August 3, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

On July 25, 2022, the petitioners filed the affidavit of Shelley Young, P.E., representative for Liquid Utilities, attesting that notice of the application was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on June 28, 2022. Additionally, on August 3, 2022, Liquid Utilities filed the publisher's affidavit of Victoria Bond, A/R clerk of the *Conroe Courier*, attesting to the publication of notice on June 30 and July 7, 2022.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for intervention	August 8, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicants for review and consent	September 30, 2022
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 7, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	October 14, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	October 21, 2022
