**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On January 26, 2022, Liquid Utilities LLC (Liquid Utilities) filed an application to obtain a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County. The application requests a service area that includes 55 acres and 159 proposed connections.

On August 5, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, which directed Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the applicant for review and consent by September 30, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs more time to prepare the maps, certificates, and tariffs for the applicant. Accordingly, Staff respectfully proposes the following amended procedural schedule.

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the applicant for review and consent	October 31, 2022
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	November 14, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	November 21, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	December 16, 2022

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request to amend the procedural schedule.
