COMMISSION STAFF’S THIRD REQUEST TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 26, 2022, Liquid Utilities LLC (Liquid Utilities) filed an application to obtain a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County. The application requests a service area that includes 55 acres and 159 proposed connections.

On November 22, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 7, which directed Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application by December 8, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs additional information from Liquid Utilities before it can complete its final recommendation. Staff plans to submit Staff’s second request for information next week. Accordingly, Staff respectfully proposes the following amended procedural schedule in consideration of the Commission’s upcoming holiday office closures.

Event	Date
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	January 19, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	February 9, 2022

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request to amend the procedural schedule.
