ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the January 26 and 27, 2022 application of Liquid Utilities LLC to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On March 14, 2022, Liquid Utilities filed supplemental information. On April 27, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness and notice.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider a petition filed until it makes a determination that it is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

By May 31, 2022, the petitioners must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies as described in the April 28, 2022 memorandum of Kathryn Eiland and Fred Bednarski III. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed. The petitioners must not issue notice until the petition is deemed administratively complete.

By June 29, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
