**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY**  
**COMPLETE AND ACCEPTED FOR FILING; AND REQUIRING NOTICE**

This Order addresses the January 28, 2022 application of Albury Manor Utility Company Inc. for a class D rate adjustment for its certificate of convenience and necessity number 11507. On February 7, 2022, Albury Manor filed a supplement to the application.


On March 2, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding administrative completeness and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds Albury Manor's application, as supplemented, administratively complete and accepted for filing under Texas Water Code § 13.1872 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.49. The ALJ establishes an effective date for the rate increase of April 15, 2022.

Under 16 TAC § 24.49(e), Albury Manor is required to provide notice to each ratepayer, using the notice Albury Manor filed on February 7, 2022. The notice must be provided only after Albury Manor receives a written Notice of Approval issued by the Commission, but at least 30 days before the effective date of the proposed rate change. Because the Notice of Approval has not yet been issued, the ALJ instructs Albury Manor not to provide notice to ratepayers until the Notice of Approval is issued in this docket.
