**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND**  
**REQUIRING PROOF OF NOTICE**

This Order address the February 3, 2022 petition of Jacob and Jennie Hilbig appealing the decision of Aqua Water Supply Corporation regarding the cost of obtaining water service.

On March 7, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition. Additionally, Commission Staff recommended that the appellants be required to file proof that notice was sent to Aqua.

The ALJ notes that on March 8, 2022, the appellants filed photo of a U.S. Postal Service certified mail receipt indicating that something was mailed to Aqua; however, the appellants failed to provide an affidavit or certificate of service indicating what was mailed to Aqua.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete. Further, the appellants must mail a copy of the appeal to Aqua WSC and file proof of filing by March 14, 2022.
