1. Why is Aqua charging the Hilbig's \$59,164.00 to provide a meter for service, which is significantly more than the regular membership fee or tap fees?
2. Why when the Hilbig's requested a joint water study, ("Wilhelm/Hilbig" water study), for two lots, as opposed to one lot, and later requested a single water study for the Hilbig lot alone (Currently in question), were the preliminary cost studies different prices for what appears to be identical materials?
3. Why is Aqua referencing the Hilbig's single family 10.5-acre tract as a subdivision, when according to Bastrop County Subdivision guidelines, no property of 10 acres or more is considered a subdivision.
4. If Aqua does not have the capacity to add one more service to its existing line, shouldn't it be Aqua's responsibility to upgrade their existing line and spread the charges out equally to all it's users/customers?
5. Isn't it extremely unfair to deny service, or hold one family hostage to bear the burden of this cost to upgrade or extend Aqua's existing water line?
