**ORDER DISMISSING CASE**

On August 25, 2022, Jennie and Jacob Hilbig filed a letter stating that they have entered into a settlement agreement with Aqua Water Supply Corporation that resolves all matters in controversy. The Hilbigs requested to withdraw their complaint and dismiss this proceeding.

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.181(d)(10) and (g)(1), a party that initiated a proceeding may agree to withdraw its complaint without prejudice at any time before the party has presented its direct case. Accordingly, the request to dismiss the complaint is **GRANTED**. Under 16 Texas

Administrative Code § 22.181(f)(2) and (6), dismissal is proper without the need for a remand when a complaint is withdrawn in this manner. Pursuant to those rules, this is a final order, and this case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** from the dockets of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Public Utility Commission of Texas.
