**ORDER NO. 4  
DENYING JOINT MOTION TO ABATE**

This Order addresses the October 12, 2022 joint motion to abate filed by 2021 FII Walnut Springs, LLC and Springs Hill Water Supply Corporation. 2021 FII Walnut Springs and Springs Hill WSC state that they are engaged in settlement negotiations regarding compensation and that abatement would provide the parties the ability to reach an agreement. 2021 FII Walnut Springs and Springs Hill WSC represent that Commission Staff is not opposed and therefore they would like to abate this case for a period of 60 days.

The administrative law judge denies 2021 FII Walnut Springs and Spring Hill WSC's joint motion to abate. This is a streamlined expedited release case. It is apparent from the relevant statute and rule, Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h) and (i), that the intent is for these proceedings to be decided quickly and in compliance with a specific schedule. 2021 FII Walnut Springs and Spring Hill WSC have cited no authority which allows deviation from the process to determine compensation set forth in TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245.
