**COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL  
DISPOSITION**

On February 8, 2022, 2021 FII Walnut Springs, LLC (FII Walnut Springs) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Springs Hill Water Supply Corporation' s (Springs Hill WSC) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10666 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). FII Walnut Springs asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Guadalupe County, which is a qualifying county.

On March 11, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2, establishing a deadline of April 21, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to file a recommendation on final disposition. On April 21, 2022, Staff filed its recommendation on final disposition, indicating that it included a final water CCN map and certificate. In error, Staff did not include the certificate. Therefore, Staff files this pleading to provide the certificate.

**I. CONCLUSION**

Staff supplements Staff's recommendation on final disposition with the attached certificate and respectfully re-urges its recommendations that the petition be approved. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with Staff's recommendations.
