APPLICATION OF UNDINE TEXAS, \$ PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION LLC FOR PASS THROUGH RATE \$ OF TEXAS

COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On February 11, 2022, Undine Texas, LLC (Undine) filed an application for approval of a proposed pass-through rate change pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2), and Ordering Paragraph No. 5, of the Notice of Approval filed in Docket No. 51828. Undine proposes a pass-through rate change for three subdivisions: Spring Creek Valley Estates Subdivision in Harris County (Public Water System (PWS) No. 1010213); Hazy Hollow East Estates Subdivision in Montgomery County (PWS No. 1700013); and River Club Water Company in Montgomery County (PWS No. 1700185).

On May 3, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 5, establishing a deadline of June 1, 2022, for Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff filed Requests for Information for Undine on May 24, 2022. Staff needs to receive and review Undine's responses before issuing its recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice. Staff respectfully requests that Staff's deadline be extended to July 27, 2022, to allow Staff time to review Undine's responses.

In accordance with Staff's extension request, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the application be found administratively complete.

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to July 27, 2022, to file its comments on the administrative completeness of the petition.
