COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On February 11, 2022, Undine Texas, LLC (Undine) filed an application for approval of a proposed pass-through rate change pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2), and Ordering Paragraph No. 5, of the Notice of Approval filed in Docket No. 51828. Undine proposes a pass-through rate change for three subdivisions: Spring Creek Valley Estates Subdivision in Harris County (PWS # 1010213); Hazy Hollow East Estates Subdivision in Montgomery County (PWS # 1700013); and River Club Water Company in Montgomery County (PWS # 1700185).

On February 16, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, establishing a deadline of March 14, 2022, for Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff respectfully requests that Staff's deadline be extended to March 28, 2022, so Staff may have sufficient time to review Undine's application. Staff has conferred with Undine's counsel and is authorized to represent that Undine is unopposed to the proposed extension.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's extension request, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the application be found administratively complete.
