ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO
CURE, AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the February 15, 2022 application of Draupnir Infrastructure Group, LLC for a certificate of operating authority (COA). On March 4, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on sufficiency of the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application deficient and incomplete. The application does not contain all of the information required under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 26.111, as more fully described in the March 4, 2022 memorandums of Rosalie Branham and Mark Filarowicz, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

Accordingly, the ALJ finds good cause exists under 16 TAC § 26.111(d) to extend the time for review of the application and amends the procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for applicant to cure the deficiencies identified in Commission Staff's memorandum	March 18, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the supplemented application and notice	April 8, 2022
