ORDER NO. 6 FINDING REVISED NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the revised notice provided by Simply Aquatics, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC in this application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery, Sabine, and San Augustine counties. On June 2, 2022, applicants filed supplemental proof of notice, attesting that revised notice, along with a copy of the map and notice sent, was mailed to current customers, landowners, neighboring systems, cities, counties, ground water conservation districts and affected parties on May 23, 2022. However, the affidavit of Arron Silas contained an incorrect docket number. On July 6, 2022, applicants were required to file a revised affidavit with the correct docket number for this proceeding. On July 7, 2022, applicants filed the revised affidavit of Aaron Silas, attesting to the provision of revised notice as described above.

On July 5, 2022 Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding applicants' revised notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds applicants' revised notice and proof thereof sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for further processing:

Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	September 15, 2022
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	September 20, 2022
