**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING PETITION REMAINS ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE,
PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE, AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES**

This Order addresses the February 22, 2022 petition of KB Home Lone Star, Inc. to amend Aqua Water Supply Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10294 in Travis County by streamlined expedited release. On April 25, and May 25 and 26, 2022, KB Home filed supplemental information. On June 8, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the petition remains administratively incomplete for the reasons described in the June 8, 2022 memorandum of Pai Liu, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Event	Date
Deadline for petitioner to file information to cure deficiencies identified in Commission Staff's memorandum	July 8, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the petition and sufficiency of notice and propose procedural schedule	August 8, 2022

A deadline for Aqua Water Supply to file a response to the petition will be established in a subsequent order.¹ Additional deadlines will be established if the petition is deemed administratively complete.

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.245(h)(6), Aqua Water's deadline to respond will not exceed 20 days from the date the petition is determined to be administratively complete.
