COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

On February 22, 2022, KB Home Lone Star, Inc. (KB Home) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Aqua Water Supply Corporation's (Aqua WSC) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10294 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). KB Home asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Travis County, which is a qualifying county.

On August 23, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6, establishing a deadline of October 3, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on final disposition. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. FINAL RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the petition and, as detailed in the attached memorandum of Chase Lipscomb, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition be approved. Specifically, Staff recommends that the petition submitted by KB Home satisfies the requirements of TWC § 13.2541(b) and 16 TAC § 24.245(h). Additionally, Aqua WSC did not file a verified response to the petition to rebut KB Home's attestations that the tract of land is not receiving service. Further, the final water CCN map and certificate are attached to this filing. Staff recommends that the final map and certificate be provided to Aqua WSC and for Aqua WSC to file a certified copy of the CCN map and a boundary description of the CCN service area in the Travis County Clerk's office, as required under TWC § 13.257(r)-(s).

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully recommends the petition be approved and respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the foregoing recommendations.

On February 22, 2022, KB Home Lone Star, Inc (KB Home) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Aqua Water Supply Corporation's (Aqua WSC) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10294 in Travis County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). KB Home asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Travis County, which is a qualifying county.

KB Home provided warranty deeds confirming ownership of the tract of land within Aqua WSC's certificated service area. In addition, KB Home submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the tract of land was not receiving water service from the CCN holder. Aqua WSC submitted an affidavit stating that it has entered discussions with KB Home regarding compensation for the release of the tract of land.

Based on the mapping review by Dave Babicki, Infrastructure Division, it was determined that the landowner's total property is approximately 136.9 acres. The tract of land in the petition for streamlined expedited release is approximately 136.9 acres, of which approximately 136.9 acres overlap Aqua WSC (CCN No. 10294) and would be decertified from CCN No. 10294.

In accordance with TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245(h), KB Home has met the Commission's requirements to allow for the release of the tract of land from Aqua WSC's CCN No. 10294. Therefore, I recommend approval of the petition. Enclosed is a final map and certificate for Commission approval.

Additionally, I recommend that a final map and certificate be provided to the CCN holder.


